The NRHA registration fee covers insurance for players and officials whilst participating in the game of roller hockey. Note the player must not reach the age by the end of the season 31st August e.g. under 15 age group must not be 15 in the current season.

New players to the sport need to register with England Roller Hockey as a non-competitor after 3 weeks. https://www.englandrollerhockey.org/Registration-Non-Competitor To play in any league you must have full competitor registration They will get 30 days free of charge. If they decide to continue after 30 days they must register, as a competitor in the appropriate age group and will receive a 50% discount on this first registration with England Roller Hockey.
